Message from Mr. Corston:

As we arrive to the first full week of October, we feel it is a good time to update our school community.

student numbers in detail. Currently there are 273 students attached to Carlin. 250 of those students are in twelve classrooms, kindergarten to grade eight at Carlin. 23 students, who may at some point return to Carlin during the school year, are with School District No. 83 through our Educational Outreach Program.

With the expected change in weather, please make sure your child is dressed appropriately. Right now, this may mean layers as there can be a significant difference in the temperature from when we arrive at school to when we go out for recess, lunch or physical education learning. There is also the time after school when students are waiting in five bus lines for pickup.

Students in grades 6-8 who ride the bus need to be prepared each day to have their mask on for the entire time of their bus ride unless there is a medical reason not to. Our middle school students are doing a very good job of wearing their masks when outside of their classroom. On any day when a student forgets their mask we have masks available at the school to distribute.

This year our two school goals are: to create a community of readers K-8 and to improve our students understanding in math as demonstrated by the collection of soft and hard data.

The week of October 19th will be our first informal reporting period of the year. This is not a report card. Teachers will make contact in a variety of ways with students' homes in relation to observations they have made and beginning of the year assessments.

We will continue to keep our Carlin community updated as changes occur related to the health check, our safety plan, and items related to the pandemic. We hope everyone has an enjoyable, relaxing Thanksgiving weekend with family and friends.
